JV Set Up to Supply Industrial Gases

to Sakai Plant of Sharp Corporation

Taiyo Nippon Sanso Corporation (TNSC) has established an equal-partnership joint venture company with Air Water Inc. for the purpose of supplying a range of industrial gases to a LCD panel manufacturing plant (which will be the world's largest) and a solar cell plant to be operated by Sharp Corporation, as well as to supporting plants to be operated by other companies, all within the "Manufacturing Complex for the 21st Century" whose construction is being planned by Sharp in Sakai City, Osaka Prefecture.
